

ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE AWARD OF 1 RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP, REF. NO.: E2S/CIR-LABRP/BI/2024/08

Applications are open for the award of 1 Research Scholarship within the scope of the Psychosocial Rehabilitation Laboratory, funded by internal resources, under the following conditions:

1. SCIENTIFIC FIELD

Psychology

2. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

General Requirements

- a) Hold a Bachelor's degree and be enrolled, at the time of the scholarship contract, in a non-degree course within the educational framework of a higher education institution, developed in collaboration with one or more R&D units.
- Have not accumulated more than two years in this type of scholarship, consecutively or intermittently, including possible renewals.
- Must not have previously been a beneficiary of any other research scholarship directly or indirectly funded by the FCT (Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology).

Candidates who obtained their degree abroad must have it recognized in Portugal, including the conversion of their final grade to the Portuguese grading scale, in accordance with Decree-Law No. 66/2018 of August 16.

Specific Requirements:

- a) Academic background: Bachelor's degree in Psychology.
 - b) Bachelor's GPA of 14 or higher.

Preferred Factors:

Preference will be given to candidates with experience and skills in:

- Collaboration with research centers or teams in Psychology and/or Health Sciences
- Health promotion initiatives
- Knowledge or experience in health-related areas, especially in monitoring health variables
- Skills in quantitative data analysis methodologies
- Proficiency in statistical analysis software
- Proficiency in qualitative analysis software
- Oral and written proficiency in English

- Strong interpersonal skills
- Immediate availability to start the scholarship (to be mentioned in the cover letter).

3. WORK PLAN

The scholar will collaborate in the work plan of the Psychosocial Rehabilitation Laboratory, including:

- a) Supporting ongoing R&D projects in the Psychosocial Rehabilitation Laboratory
- b) Assisting in scientific dissemination and publication activities
- c) Preparing technical reports on project activities

4. APPLICABLE LEGISLATION AND REGULATIONS

5. SCIENTIFIC SUPERVISION AND PLACE OF WORK

The work will be conducted at the Psychosocial Rehabilitation Laboratory of the School of Health (E2S) at the Polytechnic Institute of Porto, possibly requiring travel within the community, under the scientific supervision of Dr. Artemisa Rocha Dores.

6. DURATION AND WORKING REGIME

The scholarship is for 12 months, on an exclusive basis, as per applicable regulations.

7. MONTHLY MAINTENANCE ALLOWANCE

The scholarship amount is €990.98 per month, according to the FCT's current value table (https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores.phtml.pt), paid monthly and supplemented by voluntary social insurance, as specified in the regulations and Authorization of Expenditure Request No. ESS 5581.

8. SELECTION METHOD AND JURY COMPOSITION

The selection method will follow these criteria and their respective weights:

- a) Evaluation of Curriculum Vitae and suitability of the candidate's profile, scored from 0 to 20 (weight: 50%)
- b) Interview. The interview will be scored from 0 to 20 (weight: 50%).

The candidate with the highest combined score of 50% for curricular evaluation and 50% for the interview will be selected.

Candidates may be excluded from the competition on the following grounds:

- a) Failure to meet the required criteria (item 2);
- b) Scoring below 9.5 in any assessment component, resulting in exclusion from subsequent evaluation stages;
- c) Failure to attend the interview or provide requested additional information.

- Academic degree and diploma documents, or proof of recognition when awarded by foreign institutions, may be waived during application submission and replaced by a sworn declaration. Verification will occur during the scholarship contract phase.
- The proof indicated in item 3 may be omitted; however, the scholarship award is contingent upon a valid enrollment within six months from the date of notification.
- Applications submitted via email or by any electronic means other than those specified will not be accepted.
